Pentecost Novena

In the nine days between Jesus's Ascension and Pentecost, the disciples together with Mary—the Church, that is—were gathered in prayer. This is the model for when we pray a novena, a prayer said over nine days.

Here is a Pentecost Novena that we invite you to pray between now and Pentecost, next Sunday:

“Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.”
