Get Fed at St. Joseph

We are beginning something new this October: we will be offering faith formation for adults and children on the same night: Wednesday night. Dinner will be offered for free. We will follow dinner with a talk and small group discussion (for adults) or religious educations (for children and youth).

We're doing this for a few reasons:

- 1. In the past, we have offered adult faith formation on Thursdays. But a lot of community events often happen on Thursdays and conflict with this. In Port St. Joe, Wednesday night is often the night churches have mid-week activities.
- 2. It creates an opportunity for parishioners of all ages to be formed in the faith and connect more with fellow parishioners. In the past, we have not have opportunities—specifically for parents of younger children to grow in their faith—and hopefully this will address that.
- 3. We want invite more people to our parish: both inactive Catholics and non-Catholics. Sunday Mass is not always the best place to invite someone to first encounter the faith, so this will be an opportunity for people to encounter the faith and the parish. Inviting a friend to this is an easy opportunity for *evangelization*.

The first night for this will be **October 9 at 6:00pm**, in the parish hall. Come and get fed, both physically and spiritually!

Religious Education

The new year for religious education begins this Wednesday at 6:00 ET at the St Joseph hall with a potluck dinner for all adults and children! There will be a parent meeting immediately after dinner when children are in their classes.

Also, come greet our catechists for this year following the 11:00am Mass, in the parish hall.
