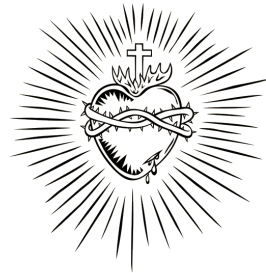
Adult Religious Study
