The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi

The feast of Corpus Christi was proposed by Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of the Church, to Pope Urban IV, in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist, emphasizing the joy of the Eucharist being the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. The traditional date for Corpus Christi was the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. Thursday was chosen because it was the day on which the Last Supper was celebrated.
